Jackson Wink MMA Academy, one of the world's most renowned mixed martial arts training facilities, is proud to introduce The NEW P-1 Athlete Visa Program—a game-changing opportunity for international fighters looking to take their careers to the next level.

Designed specifically for elite-level athletes, the P-1 Visa allows fighters to train, compete, and build their professional careers in the U.S. under the guidance of world-class coaches and alongside top-tier training partners.

By securing this visa through JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt, fighters gain exclusive access to state-of-the-art training facility in USA, personalized training with Hall Of Fame Coaches Greg Jackson and Mike Winkeljohn, and direct exposure and much higher chance to getting signed to top promotions in the world like UFC, PFL, LFA, BKFC, and many others.

What's The **Process**?

Step 1: Determine Eligibility for the P-1 Athlete Visa

- The athlete must be internationally recognized in MMA or any other combat sport.
- The athlete must be coming to the U.S. to compete or train at a Jackson Wink MMA Academy.
- The athlete must have a contract with a U.S. based organization, such as JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt.
- The athlete must demonstrate significant achievements, such as rankings, records, tournament wins, or professional experience.
- You must be in good standing with law enforcement, immigration, and not have any travel restrictions.

Step 2: Documents Required for the P-1 Visa

- Written Contract with JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt - (A signed contract confirming the management representation in the United States and/or any other sponsorship agreements with US based companies.)
- Contract with the US based Combat Sports Promotion, or the letter of intent. (if available)
- Evidence of International Recognition - Records of professional fights (Sherdog, Tapology, Fight Matrix, or promotions' official records).
- Rankings from major MMA organizations or sports commissions.
- Media coverage, articles, or interviews highlighting sports achievements.
- Awards, championship titles, or notable victories.
- Schedule of Events & Competitions (if applicable)
- List of upcoming professional fights or planned training camps in the US.
- Support Letters from Experts in MMA - Letters from recognized MMA trainers, coaches, promoters, or organizations stating the athlete's professional standing.
- Proof of Financial Support and the ability to sustain yourself in the United States – (Bank statements, sponsorship agreements, or a letter confirming financial coverage. JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt can not be your sponsor.)
- Copy of ID & Passport (valid for at least six months beyond intended stay).
- Any Previous U.S. Visas (if applicable).

Step 3: File

- We file your application and all the supporting documents on-line at Immigration & Naturalization Services
- ALL documents must include copies, and must be transcribed into English and notarized.
- Retain all of your original documents for interview.
- Processing Time: 3-6 months (approximate)
- Visa approval is not guaranteed.

Standard Filing Fees

- **Initial INS Application and Filing Fee:** \$1,015
- **JW Filing Service Fee:** \$2,000
- **Visa INS Application Fee:** \$205 (charged upon approval before INS interview)
- **Total:** \$3,220 (\$1,000 JW Retainer Fee + \$1,015 INS Fee due at start of the process, \$1,000 due when paperwork is ready to be filed, \$205 before interview if approved)
- **Processing Time:** 3 – 6 Months.

When you send payment, you agree to pay for a government service. Filing fees are final and non-refundable, regardless of any action that is taken on your application. Refunds are unavailable under any circumstances. If you pay by credit card or debit card, you cannot dispute the payment.

** By working with JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt you get a substantial discount for services rendered. Normal attorney fees range from \$7,000 to \$15,000.*

Expedited Fees

- **Initial INS Application and Filing Fee:** \$2,805
- **JW Filing Service Fee:** \$4,000
- **Visa INS Application Fee:** \$205 (charged upon approval before INS interview)
- **Total:** \$7,010 (\$2,000 JW Retainer Fee + \$2,805 INS Fee due at start of the process, \$2,000 due when paperwork is ready to be filed, \$205 before interview if approved)
- **Processing Time:** 15 – 20 day response time.

F.A.Q.

Am I eligible for a P-1 Visa?

- The athlete must be internationally recognized in MMA or any other combat sport.
- The athlete must be coming to the U.S. to compete or train at a distinguished level at Jackson Wink MMA Academy.
- The athlete must have a contract with a U.S.-based organization, such as JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt, or any of Combat Sports Organizations.
- The athlete must demonstrate significant achievements, such as rankings, records, tournament wins, or professional experience.
- You must be in good standing with immigration, law enforcement and not have any travel restrictions.

How long is the processing time?

Processing time varies on many factors, on average the processing time can be between 2-8 months.

How long can I stay in America with P-1 Visa and what happens next?

The maximum allowable initial stay with P-1 Visa is up to 5 years, but this may be extended by up to 5 more years giving a maximum duration of 10 years. After you come and compete in America, securing employment, you will have a chance to transition to EB-1 Visa that allows you to stay in The United States indefinitely with an opportunity to apply for a Green Card.

Am I guaranteed a Visa?

Unfortunately, we are unable to guarantee that you will be approved for your visa. We help you to build the case to maximize your chances. The approval decisions are made by Immigration and Naturalization services (INS).

What payment methods do you accept?

For Domestic Payments we accept Certified Check, Cash, Zelle, CashApp, or Venmo. For International Payments we accept PayPal or Bitcoin.

Can I pay JW Service Fee in installments?

Yes, you can pay in 4 equal installments of \$500 for Standard Application, and 4 equal installments of \$1,000 for Expedited Application.

Are Refunds Available?

The US government does not issue refunds for denied visas. Our Service Fees are also not refundable.

If your P-1 Visa is declined, the contract between JW Worldwide Sports Mgmt and the Athlete is void. We can still provide a Visa Invitation Letter for regular tourist visa for \$150.

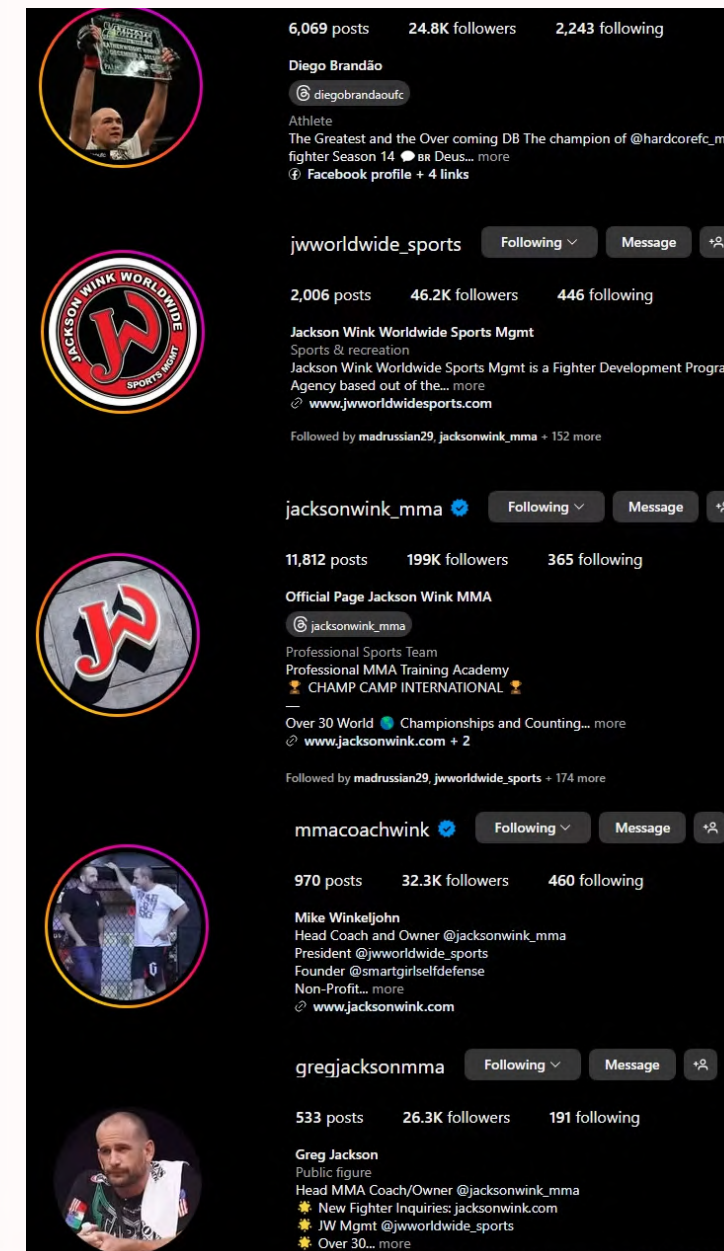

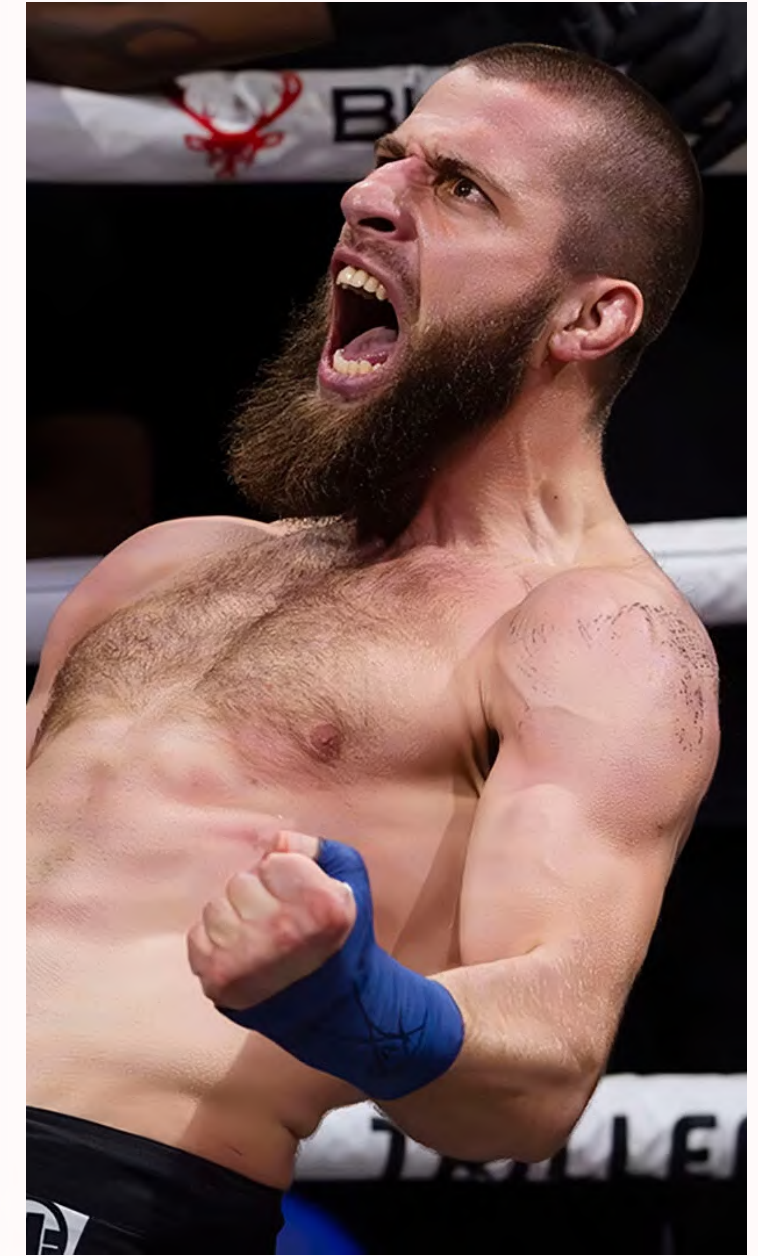
